It took a near miss accident to call Specialized in to perform an analysis and appraisal of all pallet racking in our Clifton yard and warehouse.

What they discovered was that the racking was weather beaten resulting in rust and decay in both cross arms and uprights, compromising the overall weight load capacity in many areas of the racking system.

After reviewing the appraisal, we agreed to have Specialized perform the necessary work.

The crews were briefed and informed of the company's safety rules and regulations while working on the property. Once the crews were briefed on the company's safety rules/regs, they immediately began to disassemble, sort and remove all questionable material.

After the material was disassembled and sorted, the installation of racking based on our configuration began. The installation and assembly was performed to specifications by the manufacturer. In addition to the assembly process and because most of the racks were installed outdoors, leveling of the racks was paramount. Specialized studied this challenge and modified the racking system to correct any unlevel ground issues. Finally, the installation was completed after they stenciled the weight capacity of each cross arm for clear visibility by forklift operators. This was great because it leaves no guessing by anyone.
